I. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN **REVIEW FOR FILE NO. PDEV14-041:** A modification to a previously approved Development Plan (File No. PDEV12-018) that proposed to construct a public self-storage facility on 3.5 acres of land for property generally located at the northwest corner of the 60 Freeway and Mountain Avenue, at 2314 S. Mountain Avenue, within the C1 (Shopping Center Commercial) zone. The modification proposes to add a 36,762 square foot (3rd Story) addition to an existing 73,525 square foot commercial building for a total building square footage of 115,138 square feet.
