- 1) A.D. means Assessment District; C.F.D. means Community Facilities District; SLMD means Street Lighting Maintenance District; and OPMAD means Ontario Parkway Maintenance Assessment District.
- 2) The assessments in A.D. 103 were modified and confirmed on August 15, 1989.

 The total amount of authorized bonded indebtedness for A.D. 103 is \$20,308,916.83. The first bonds issued were Series 1989-A in the amount of \$18,000,000.
- The remaining bonds authorized in the amount of \$2,308,916.83, will not be issued.
- 4) The total amount of authorized bonded indebtedness for C.F.D. 1 is \$13,200,000. Bonds have been issued in series: \$8,000,000 1985 Series A and \$4,000,000 1987 Series B. These bonds totaling \$12,000,000 are the obligation of Zones A and B of the district. The remaining bonds in the amount of \$1,200,000 are authorized for Zone C of the district. It was determined that bonds will not be issued for Zone C.
- 5) The final year of the tax levy within C.F.D. 1, Zones A & B was 2005.
- The first parkway landscaping maintenance district was formed on May 4, 1976 with the approval of Resolution 7908, creating Maintenance District No. MD 76-1.

 Many similar landscaping maintenance districts were created in the years that followed. The districts were reorganized on June 1, 1982 with the approval of Resolution No. 9632.

 The reorganization resulted in the consolidation of the many, small districts into Ontario Parkway Maintenance Assessment Districts No. 1, 2 and 3.

 Additional territory may be annexed into these three districts.
