

# CIT Emergency Grant Program

## WHAT IS THE CIT EMERGENCY GRANT PROGRAM?

This program provides grants of up to \$5,000 to qualified very low income homeowners to assist in the removal of health and safety code violations related to the building structure.



## ELIGIBLE IMPROVEMENTS

- Abatement of code violations
- Accessibility modifications
- Demolition of unpermitted, deteriorated, or unsafe improvements
- Electrical repairs
- HVAC Systems
- Plumbing/sewer pipes and fixtures
- Roofing
- Smoke detectors
- Carbon Monoxide detectors
- Structural repairs/modifications
- Water heater repairs

## WHO QUALIFIES?

Household with incomes at or below the income limits shown below are eligible to participate:

1	\$21,750
2	\$24,850
3	\$27,950
4	\$31,050
5	\$33,550
6	\$36,050
7	\$38,550
8	\$41,000

Income limits are subject to change.



## ELIGIBLE PROPERTIES

Eligible properties must be owner-occupied properties that have been cited for one or more code violations related to the building structure.
