SUBJECT: Uniform Allowance Reporting to CalPERS

The City will begin reporting the monetary value of uniforms provided to employees represented by AFSCME and SBPEA as special compensation to CalPERS as a result of the recent CalPERS audit findings and in accordance with California Government Code Section 20636(c)(6) and California Code of Regulations Title 2, Section 571(a)(5). Based on the current pricing for the rental and cleaning of uniforms, the City will report to CalPERS the monetary value of the uniform allowance at the rate of \$8.10 per pay period per employee. All employees in AFSCME are eligible for the reporting of special compensation. Employees represented by SBPEA in the classifications below are also eligible.

- Custodial Services Supervisor
- Fleet Services Supervisor
- Irrigation Conservation Specialist
- Water Production Operator

Please take the necessary actions to implement the reporting of the monetary value of uniforms to CalPERS effective July 1, 2012.
