#### Abstract

The "historical drinking society" known as E Clampus Vitus originated in what is now W. Virginia between 1799 and 1802. Ephraim Bee is considered the father of this spoof of fraternal organizations. The society was brought to California in 1850 by Joe Zumwalt who established a chapter in Hangtown (Placerville). By the 1950's, California had chapters up and down the state.

The local chapter, Billy Holcomb, was founded in 1969 at Los Flores Ranch in San Bernardino County by L. Burr Belden, a noted Southern California historian. The Chapter is active in State, Local, and county Historical Societies and works with the Bureau of land Management (BLM), and the CA Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to place plaques at greater and lesser historical sites within its territory of both San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. Since October 1969, Holcomb Chapter has erected and dedicated 109 plaques, including those along parts of the Mojave Road, The Patton Desert Training Center (C.A.M.A.), Route 66, Speed of Light Experiments, various Historical Buildings and Other Edifices, Local Native Sites and Ruins, and other varied and sundry Persons, Places and events of Historical significance. A "clampout" is arranged, cement is poured, a dedication given and a "Keepsake" written after each dedication.

In 1998, a fundraiser for the ECV was held at Guasti Mansion with the proceeds going to the purchase of a fire safe for the Model Colony Room. Daniel Mikesell, Ontario Mayor and San Bernardino County Supervisor was active in this society during his lifetime.
