

Mandatory Recycling

Assembly Bill 341 mandates recycling for businesses producing four or more cubic yards of solid waste per week. In most cases, businesses can save money by implementing a recycling program.

Assembly Bill 1826 mandates food waste recycling for qualifying businesses.

REFUSE

As the sole permitted hauler of commercial refuse, the City of Ontario offers businesses their choice of bin or roll off sizes for collection from 1 to 6 times a week.



CONSTRUCTION WASTE

For large amounts of debris, construction projects, or inert materials (concrete, asphalt and dirt), the City provides roll offs for regularly scheduled or on-call service. Construction sites can commingle their recyclable material (wood, drywall, metal, and inerts) in the same roll off, and the City makes it easy to comply with construction and demolition recycling mandates.

FOOD WASTE

Food waste can be collected in separate containers. Restaurants, markets, and food distributors are likely candidates for the service. City staff is ready to work with your business to set up this service.



WOOD AND GREEN WASTE RECYCLING

Clean wood, plywood, particle board, pallets and green waste are collected in the same bin. All sizes of bins are available. This is a discounted program.



COMMINGLED RECYCLING

Recycle and save money! For commingled recyclables, the same size containers are available, but at a significantly reduced rate. With mandatory commercial recycling in effect, you can be in compliance, save money and help the environment, all at the same time.
