It has been an extraordinary summer in the City of Ontario and I am pleased to provide you with an overview of just a few of the successful events and projects as envisioned by your City Council.

On June 17, 2015, the Ontario Mayor and City Council unanimously approved a structurally balanced budget for Fiscal Year 2015-16. The total overall budget of \$491,951,228 was balanced without the use of any reserves or one-time monies. Moreover, the budget provides funding to support high quality public safety and municipal services, maintenance and expansion needs of the City's infrastructure and facilities, and the investment and reinvestment of City resources into the community.

A major component of the City's budget was the continued allocation of support for the transfer of Ontario International Airport to local control under the Ontario International Airport Authority. This investment is critical as the passenger count fell from 7.2 million in 2007 to 3.9 million in 2013. This represents total economic damage of \$3.6 billion and 10,700 fewer jobs. We continue to use all legal, legislative, and political means to expedite a transfer of the Airport.

Despite the difficulty in finding flights at Ontario International Airport, 38,280 attendees from all over the world enjoyed the region's milestone Huck Finn Jubilee Bluegrass Music Festival, now known as the "Premier Bluegrass Festival on the West Coast." The Greater Ontario Convention & Visitors Bureau, overseen by the City of Ontario, booked 23 bands for the three day event (June 12 - June 14) that featured world class acts including a performance by actor/comedian Steve Martin. The event infused \$7.1 million into the local economy and helped secure 2,257 room nights at area hotels. Next year's event will take place on June 10 – 12, 2016; and more information is available online at www.HuckFinn.com.

Additional world famous events are right around the corner. Downtown Ontario will host the third annual Route 66 Cruisin' Reunion from September 18 – 20, and will feature thousands of classic cars and over 200,000 attendees. This event gives our community an opportunity to showcase Downtown Ontario's new Town Square, showcase car enthusiast vendors, and welcome world class musical entertainment suitable for the entire family. To register your vehicle or obtain additional information, please visit www.Route66CruisinReunion.com.

Finally, this Fall I invite all of you to explore Downtown's newest feature, the Ontario Civic Center Community Conservation Park. This 1.3 acre site on the south side of Ontario City Hall has been designed to educate the community about the benefits of conservation through interactive features and sustainable park amenities. Interactive structures will include a sun clock, play garden, artistic windmill, rock climbing play equipment, fossil digs, garden playhouse, butterfly garden, Ontario water history display and an outdoor education amphitheater. This \$3 million dollar project has been entirely funded by a grant from the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program and advances our commitment to making the Civic Center a model for sustainability and ingenuity. This is the first such open space in the region, and I look forward to seeing you there.

## **Discover Historic Downtown**

Enjoy a leisurely stroll through downtown with the Historic Downtown Ontario self-guided walking tour map in hand. Discover the people, businesses, and architecture associated with Ontario's buildings and sites. Did you know that downtown was home to Los Angeles famed architect Paul Williams' "Old Post Office" building on Emporia Avenue, which is now used for an art gallery and work/live lofts? See a collection of Work Progress Administration (WPA) architectural gem buildings, such as the Museum of History and Art, Ontario, on South Euclid Avenue and the United States Post Office on East Holt Boulevard. Don't forget to have a look at the WPA-sponsored artwork displayed in the lobby of the post office. Complete your tour by visiting Ontario Through the Years history mural located at Ontario Town Square, located on North Euclid Avenue between B and C Streets. The images included in the mural highlight events,

people, and places that helped shape Ontario from "The Vision" Era to the "Commitment to Community" Era. The mural commemorates and celebrates Ontario's past and the framework it has established for the future. A printed copy of the tour guide may be picked up at the Ovitt Family Community Library, the Museum of History and Art, Ontario, or at the Ontario City Hall. ## Planning a Garage Sale?



The City of Ontario will only be allowing yard sales to occur on 4 weekends throughout the year. The upcoming Yard Sale Weekends in 2015

are: August 7, 8, 9; and November 6, 7, 8. Dates will be posted on the City's website.

Residents will no longer need to go to City Hall to get a garage sale permit. Items for sale must be used merchandise that was owned by the household. One 6 square foot sign can be placed in the front yard to advertise the sale. After August 6, 2010, holding a garage sale on any other days, besides the weekends designated by the City, will result in a possible citation or fine.

The City is limiting the dates for yard sales to help prevent traffic and parking problems in our neighborhoods, and to keep the City attractive.



## myOntario Smart Phone Application

The City of Ontario has unveiled the "myOntario" Smart Phone application that allows residents with iPhones and Android phones to point, click and send photos of maintenance issues such as graffiti, potholes, roadside debris, shopping carts, storm drains, street sweeping, lane striping, traffic signs, sidewalk, curb, and gutter maintenance, tree trimming, park maintenance, weed abatement, and sprinkler problems.



iPhone and Android users may download the "myOntario" application for free from the iPhone App Store and Android Market by searching for the keyword "myOntario". Once installed, users will simply open the application and follow the prompts to take a picture of the issue and then tap "submit". Using built-in global positioning system technology, "myOntario" will attach a location to the picture and route the information about the problem to the appropriate City department for resolution.

City staff and Vendors will now be able to respond like a business, using better technology, encouraging efficiency and faster response times.
