

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas<sup>®</sup>) offers bill assistance programs that can help.

- <u>CARE program</u> provides a 20 percent discount on the monthly gas bill for eligible households. In addition, those who qualify and are approved within 90 days of starting new gas service will also receive a \$15 discount on the Service Establishment Charge.
- The <u>Gas Assistance Fund</u> provides a one-time grant of up to \$100 to qualified customers experiencing difficulty with paying their gas bills. Grants are available between February 8, 2011 and April 2011 (or until funds are no longer available) on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Under the <u>Medical Baseline</u> program, customers may qualify for an additional allowance of gas at lower rates if someone in their household has a life-threatening illness, is seriously disabled, or requires more heat in winter due to a qualifying health condition. There are no income qualification guidelines for this program.

SoCalGas also has helped secure increased federal energy assistance funding, on behalf of our customers. Federal <u>Low-Income Home Energy</u> <u>Assistance Program</u> funds are distributed through local community-based organizations, assistance agencies and certain government agencies. Priority is given to families who spend a high percentage of their income on energy and/or have elderly or disabled members, and to families with children under three years of age.
