JOINT MEETINGS

Special Meetings of the Ontario City Council and Ontario Housing Authority were held on April 25, 2014, in the Conference Room of Assemblymember Freddie Rodriguez at 13160 7th Street, Chino, CA 91710.

CALL TO ORDER

Assemblymember Rodriguez called the Joint meetings to order at 10:00 a.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

COUNCIL MATTERS

AB2574 (RODRIGUEZ) – GOLD LINE

Discussion by the group included background on AB2574 (Rodriguez), the position of support by Metro Gold Line, and the concerns and opposition of SANBAG. After input from SANBAG, Gold Line, IEEP, LA Metro, and the impacted cities of Ontario, Montclair and Upland, Assemblymember Rodriguez stated that he appreciated the comments of interested parties and will take the input into consideration before deciding the next step in consideration of his bill.

The various parties dispersed after approximately an hour; and Mayor Leon, Mayor pro Tem Wapner, Council Members Bowman and Dorst-Porada remained to discuss with City Manager Boling the previously requested light rail Council workshop. After brief discussion,

the Council provided guidance to City Manager Boling in light of Assemblymember Rodriguez' likely action to hold his proposed legislation until the next legislative session. Accordingly, a future workshop in the fall on a more general topic of transportation was requested. City Manager Boling suggested perhaps an August meeting for the workshop, and Council concurred.

There being no further business the Joint Meetings were adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
