She has received numerous awards as a pioneering pilot, to include her commanding role in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). She was the Marine Corps' first African American Female pilot, first African American woman on the Nashville Police Department's motorcycle squad, a Camp Pendleton Female Athlete of the Year and two-time titleholder in their Strongest Warrior Competition, and a running back for the women's pro football team, the San Diego 'Sunfire.'

FlyGirl's first signature book, Zero to Breakthrough,[™] was released in 2011.

FlyGirl is married and resides in the Atlanta, GA area. In 2015, she gave birth to "FlyBaby," her gutsiest move yet!
