


- 4' MINIMUM SIDEWALK IS NOT REQUIRED IF SIDEWALK SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED BEYOND THE RIGHT-OF-WAY (SEE NOTE # 4).
- MAXIMUM SLOPE= 10% FOR 8" CURB FACE AND 8.33% FOR 6" CURB FACE. SLOPE MAY BE INCREASED TO 12% WITH CITY ENGINEER APPROVAL.

NOTES

- (1) CURB RETURN RADII VARIES ACCORDING TO PARKWAY WIDTHS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLE TYPE OR AS APPROVED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.
- COMMERCIAL DRIVE APPROACH SHALL BE USED FOR ALLEY ENTRANCE UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE 2 CITY ENGINEER.
- BCR & ECR OF APPROACH SHALL NOT BEGIN CLOSER THAN 5' FROM PROPERTY LINE AND A MINIMUM OF 20' FROM A STREET CURB RETURN OR AS REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF ONTARIO ACCESS GUIDELINES. (3)
- 5' WIDE PUBLIC EASEMENT MAY BE REQUIRED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK BEYOND THE RIGHT OF WAY.
 - CONCRETE SHALL BE CLASS 520—C-2500 PER SECTION 201 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, CURED WITH TYPE 1-D $\,$ (5) CURING COMPOUND.
 - COMMERCIAL DRIVE APPROACH SHALL BE POURED MONOLITHICALLY UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE CITY ENGINEER. (6)
