Administrative History/Biographical Note

Hobart Romig Alter was born December 13, 1897 in Clay, Washington County, Iowa a son of former Ontario Mayor Ezra Alter. He married Katherine Laidlaw on August 7, 1919 in Ontario. They made their home at 126 Rosewood Court. Hobart R. Alter was Assemblyman for the 72nd District from 1932-1934, president of the Ontario School Board from 1936-1945, Kiwanis Lieutenant Governor of Division 15, and a violinist with the Desert Symphony and concertmaster with the Palm Springs Symphony. He passed away on May 13, 1984 in Laguna Beach, California and is entombed at the Bellevue Mausoleum in Ontario.
