

Silent Disco Frequently Asked Questions

What is a “Silent Disco”?

- A silent disco is an event where people dance to music listened to on wireless headphones. Rather than using a speaker system, music is broadcast to wireless headphones worn by participants. The different colored lights let everyone know what station you are listening to.

Do I need to pre-register?

- Yes, pre-registration is required, and it is a \$5 rental fee.
- You will need to check in upon arrival to receive your headphones

When and where is the Silent Disco?

- The Silent Disco will take place Friday, April 26, at Ontario Town Square (224 N. Euclid Ave.)

What time does the Silent Disco start?

- 5 PM – 6 PM – Inclusive and Sensory Friendly Hours: These hours are designated for participants who may require special accommodations.
- 6:30 PM – 9 PM Family Friendly Hours

Can I bring my own headphones? Can I keep the headphones provided?

- Please **DO NOT** bring your own headphones, as the headphones provided are in sync with the DJ's equipment.
- The headphones provided **MUST** be returned at the conclusion of the event. ID is needed for checking out headphones.

Where can I park for the Silent Disco?

- Parking is available at the parking structure on C St or anywhere public parking is open.

Will food be provided? Can I bring food to the event?

- Food will be available for purchase by food vendors.
- Participants are welcome to bring their own food as well. Tables and chairs are provided at this event.
