

The Grand Ontario Egg Hunt Frequently Asked Questions

What is The Grand Ontario Egg Hunt?

 An opportunity for participants ages 3-12 to make crafts, play games, and search for hidden eggs that are filled with candy and toys.

Do I need to pre-register?

- Yes, pre-registration is required
 - o Residents: \$5
 - o Non-Residents: \$7
- Space is limited, so register early

When and where is The Grand Ontario Egg Hunt?

- The Grand Ontario Egg Hunt will be offered on 2 dates and at 2 locations.
- Sunday, March 24, at Celebration Park North (4980 S. Celebration Ave.)
 from 10 AM to 12 PM
- Saturday, March 30, at Ontario Town Square (224 N. Euclid Ave.) from 10 AM – 12 PM

Can I register for both days?

Participants can register for one or both dates.

Do I need to check-in on the day of the event?

 Yes, check-in begins promptly at 10 AM, and a wristband will be given to each participant.

Will all ages complete the egg hunt at the same time?

- For the safety of our participants, we have created designated agespecific times for each egg hunt. The times and age divisions will be the same for both event dates. The age limit is strictly enforced.
 - o 10:30 AM Ages 3-5
 - o 10:45 AM Ages 6-7
 - o 11 AM Ages 8-10
 - o 11:15 AM Ages 11-12

What should participants bring to the event?

Participants must bring a basket for all the eggs they'll find.

Are parents allowed in the egg hunt area?

• For the safety of participants, parents must remain outside the egg hunt area. They can cheer on and supervise children from the sidelines.

Where can I park for The Grand Ontario Egg Hunt?

• Parking is available anywhere public parking is open.

The Search for Grand Eggs Hidden throughout Ontario Parks!

- Beginning March 25, all ages are invited to locate one of the various Giant Easter Eggs hidden around the city.
- The eggs are redeemable for prizes at the second Egg Hunt Event on Saturday, March 30 ONLY at Ontario Town Square (224 N. Euclid Ave.) from 10 AM – 12 PM
- Rules:
 - Limit one egg per household
 - Only Ontario residents are eligible, and proof of residency will be required to redeem prizes
 - o City of Ontario employees and their family members are not eligible
 - Prizes may not be substituted for a different prize
