B. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT, DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP REVIEW FOR FILE NOS. PDEV11-010 & PMTT11-010 (PM 19336): A Development Plan (File No. PDEV11-010) to construct four industrial buildings totaling approximately 539,437 square feet on approximately 29 acres of land and a Tentative Parcel Map (File No. PMTT11-**010**) to subdivide approximately 29 acres into four parcels and one letter lot, for property generally located at the northwest corner of Etiwanda Avenue and the I-10 Freeway within the Light Industrial land use designation of the Crossroads Business Park Specific Plan. The proposed project is located within the Airport Influence Area of Ontario International Airport (ONT) and was evaluated and found to be consistent with the policies and criteria of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for ONT.
