A. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT REVIEW FOR FILE NO. PCUP13-028: A Conditional Use Permit request to establish and operate a body, paint and customization shop on 0.79 acres, for property located at 1336 E. Holt Boulevard, within the M1 (Limited Industrial) zoning district. The proposed project is located within the Airport Influence Area of Ontario International Airport (ONT) and was evaluated and found to be consistent with the policies and criteria of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for ONT. Staff has determined that the project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to § 15301 (Class 1-Existing Facilities) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. B. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT REVIEW FOR FILE NO. PCUP13-032: A Conditional Use Permit to establish beer and wine sales for consumption on the premises (Type 41 ABC license - On-Sale Beer and Wine for Bona Fide Public Eating Place) within an existing restaurant (Archibald's) within the C1 (Shopping Center Commercial) zone, located west of the northwest corner of Archibald Avenue and Riverside Drive, at 2685 East Riverside Drive. The proposed project is located within the Airport Influence Area of Ontario International Airport (ONT) and was evaluated and found to be consistent with the policies and criteria of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for ONT. Staff has determined that the project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to § 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines.
