A-03. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVIEW FOR FILE NO. PDEV15-007: A Development Plan to construct 135 single-family homes on approximately 13.72 gross acres of land within Planning Area 10A of The Avenue Specific Plan, generally located south of Schaefer Avenue, north of Edison Avenue between Haven and Turner Avenues. The proposed project is located within the Airport Influence Area of Ontario International Airport (ONT) Airport and was evaluated and found to be consistent

with the policies and criteria of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans (ALUCP) for ONT Airport. The impacts to this project were previously analyzed in an addendum to The Avenue Specific Plan EIR (SCH# 2005071109) that was adopted by the City Council on June 17, 2014 and was prepared pursuant to the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act. City Council presentation of Awards.

Planning Director Scott Murphy, presented the staff report. He stated that staff is recommending the Planning Commission recommend approval of File No. PADV15-004 to the City Council.
