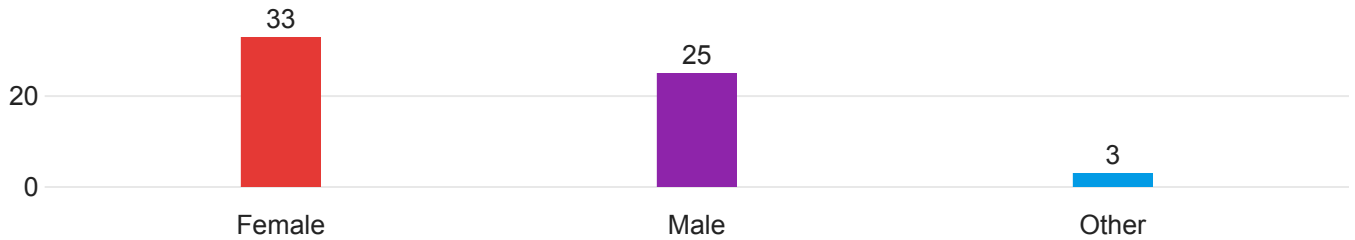


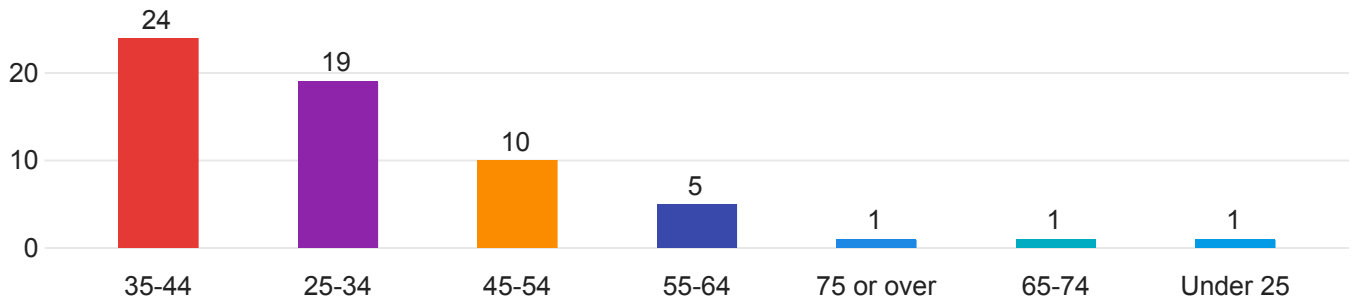
Q3 - Please indicate the gender with which you identify - Selected Choice

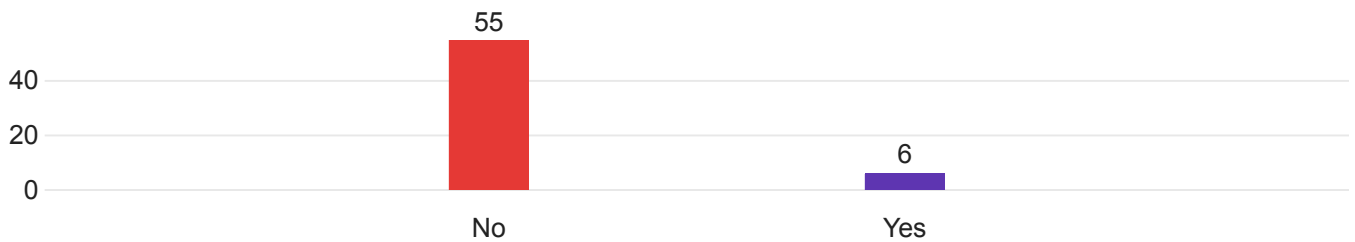
Q4 - What is your age?

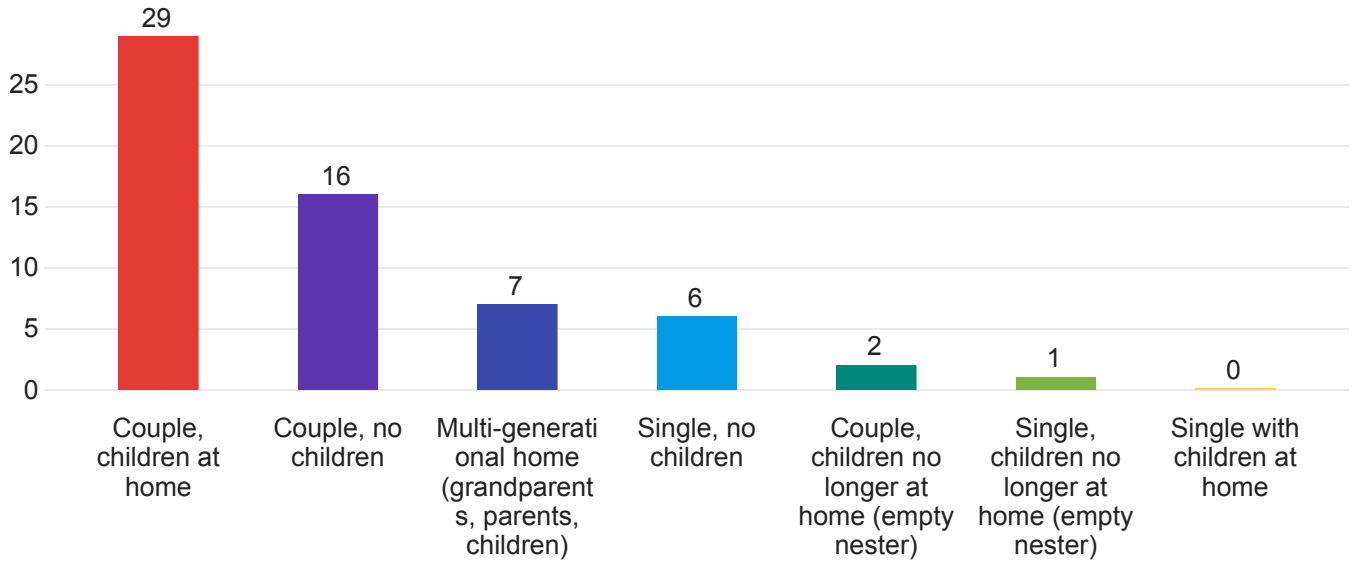
Q5 - Does your household have a need for ADA-accessible (Americans with Disabilities act) facilities and services?

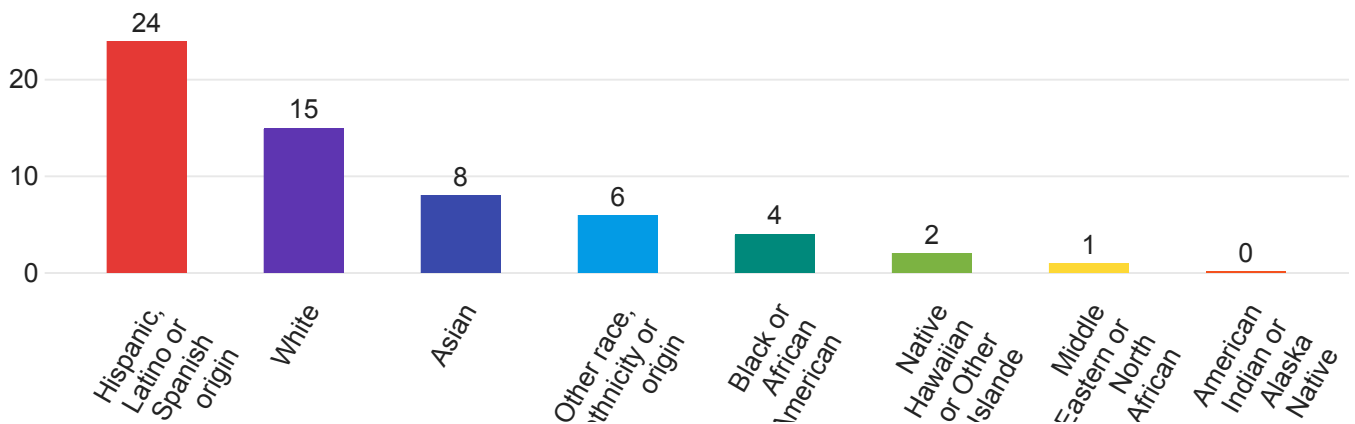
Q7 - Do you own a dog?

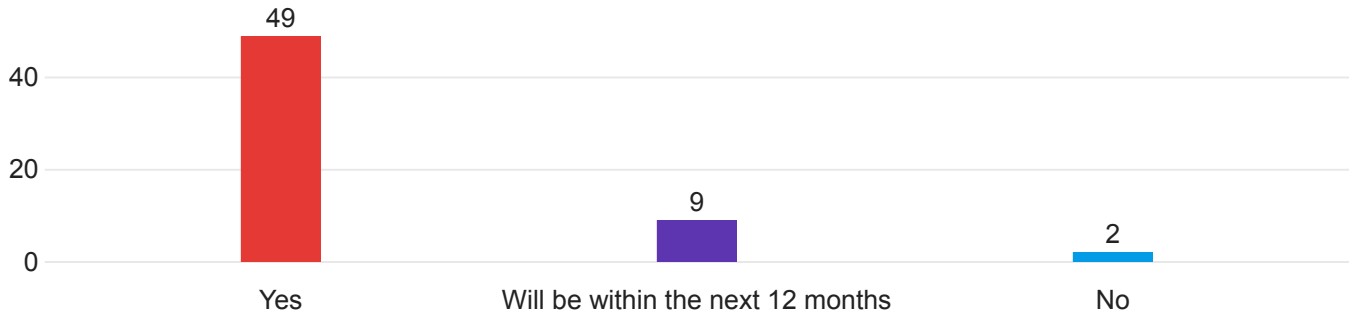

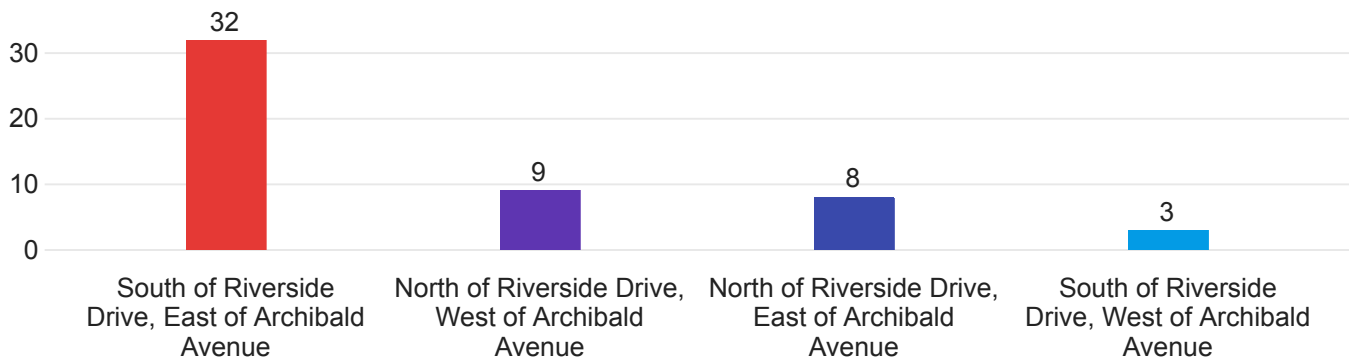
Q9 - Do you live in Ontario?

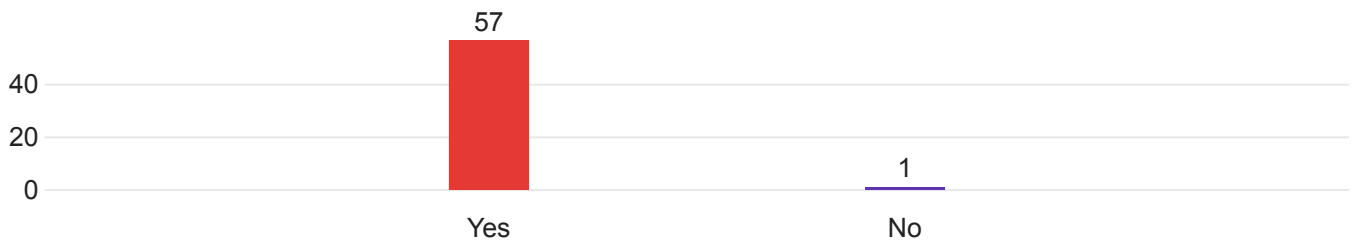
Q10 - Where do you live/plan to live?

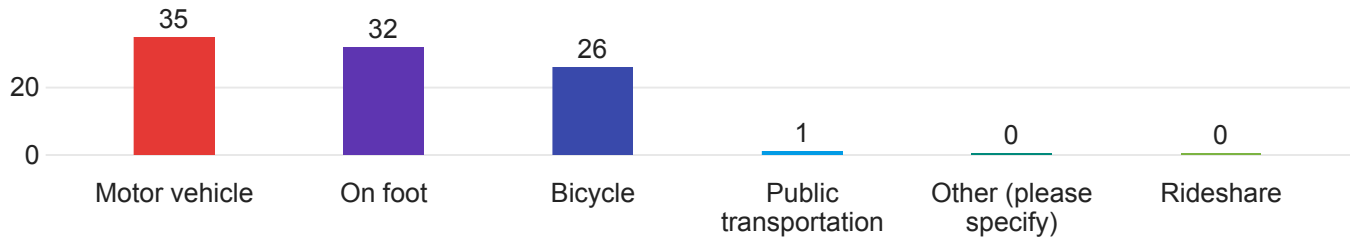
Q11 - Do you think you and/or members of your household will visit the Great Park when the first phase is built?

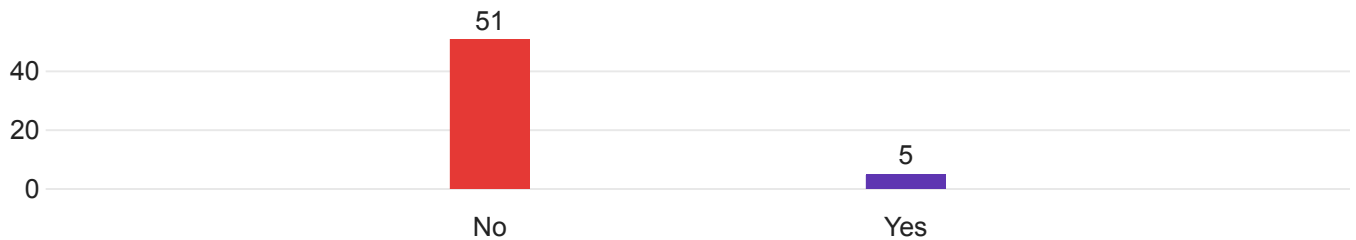
Q12 - What transportation method would you use to get to the park?

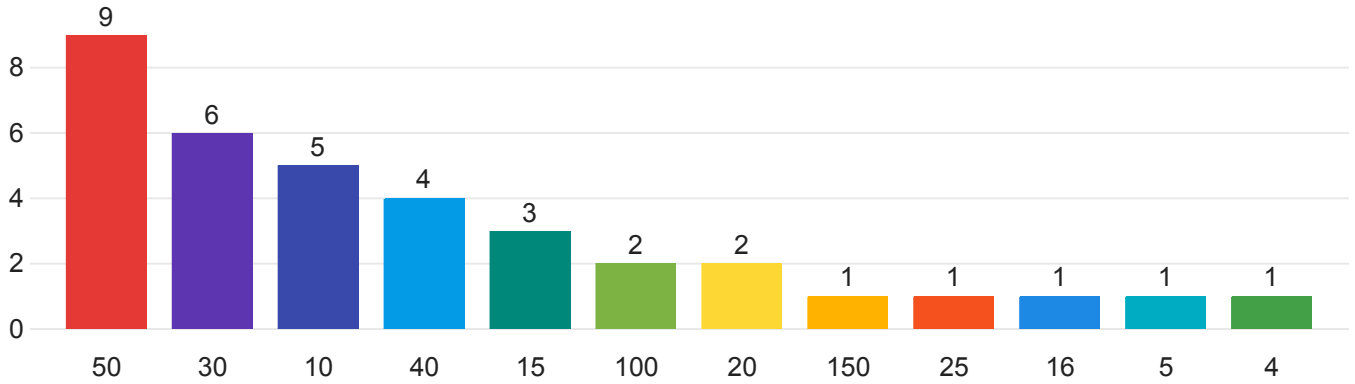

Like to see some sort of small animal or reptile zoo with ponds and waterfall...fountains throughout the park. Ontario needs to step up in its park designs and shopping areas the way Rancho and Chino Hills has. Ontario os the biggest city in the county of Ontario and we should be leading the way in architectural design.

Please have dog water and poop bag stations located all around the park for easy access.

Parking lot should be away from residential neighboring streets. Utilize school parking, locate lots west and east of park, next to Archibald and Haven. Lighting should be kept to a minimum/low light setting after a certain time to not disturb neighbors. Patrol for illicit activities at night. Avoid massive field lights like baseball soccer field lights. Theater/stage to be place furthest away from residential area. Main vehicle entrance to be placed on Archibald and Haven, same as bus routes. Trail path distance marker. Eucalyptus shouldn't be a main artery.

I attended the phase one meeting yesterday, some aspects that I want to encourage are the trails, performance stage, playgrounds, forest like feel and market alley for food trucks and farmers market. I want to highly discourage a lake or pond, they bring gnats and other bugs, get murky, and I'm always worried small children will fall in. A splash pad would be fine, but there is no need for a lake or pond- please.

Parking on grand park street an issue, lighting (dusk to dawn)? possible ballard lighting on pathways. Noise a big concern, as my house backs up to grand park St. Noise after 10PM is a city ordinance.

I love the idea of a community garden and I think this will bring people together to meet their neighbors. Also, I like the idea of fall festivals (think Laguna Beach's Sawdust Festival) and pumpkins, hayrides, art exhibits, crafts and winter wonderland with Santa's village and a temporary ice skating rink. Lastly, have one trail that is half a mile or a full mile exactly for runners and especially the local high school cross country team that will be practicing here.

Would like the concept to remain more private rather than busy. I wouldn't want to lose the residential feel of the new communities being built. As a new homeowner in the area I would like a peaceful park rather than a noisy environment.

Excited for a place like this to exist in Ontario. Love the idea of educating about the history of the area. Maybe exhibits or even playgrounds can be incorporated with a history lesson on hand.
