

## \*UPDATE\*

During the continued search of "Cactus City" area, and with cooperation from suspect Dalen Ware, Ontario Detectives were led to the discovery of a shallow grave. This grave contains the suspected remains of Julia Jacobson and her dog Boogie.

The remains were discovered near the I-10 Freeway and Box Canyon Road with the aid of the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Cadaver dog Ellie. The remains found are consistent with a female adult and a dog.

This discovery was possible due to the combined efforts of the Ontario Police Department, the San Diego Police Department, the San Bernardino County Sheriff Department, the Riverside County Sheriff Department and the US Marshals Pacific Southwest Fugitive Task Force.
