ONTARIO FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONDS TO SINGLE STORY RESTAURANT FIRE

The Ontario Fire Department responded to a commercial fire in a single story restaurant at 2535 S. Euclid Avenue. At 5:25 AM, the Ontario Fire Dispatch Center received a 911 call reporting fire coming from the roof of the structure. At 5:32 AM, the first arriving Engine Company found a large column of smoke coming from the roof to the rear. Fire attack was immediately initiated. Primary and secondary searches for victims were completed, and no victims were located. The fire was confined to the property of origin, and brought under control within 35 minutes.

The Ontario Fire Department responded with six Paramedic Engine Companies, two Truck Companies, two Battalion Chiefs, a Fire Investigator, and three overhead personnel for a total of 38 fire personnel. The Ontario Police Department responded with several units for traffic control. American Medical Response assisted with one paramedic ambulance. Chino Valley Independent Fire District provided mutual aid assistance for fire station coverage. Southern California Edison and Southern California Gas Company personnel responded to assist with utility control. There were no injuries to responders. The cause of the fire is still under investigation. Property and content loss has not been estimated.
